

– Has Come True! City approval has been obtained and Grace Center has signed an agreement to purchase our existing building from Samaritan Health Services. We give our sincere thanks to Samaritan Health Services for assisting us in the process. They will retain ownership of the undeveloped part of the property next to Grace Center. Over the next several weeks, watch for demolition of the unused portion of the building, construction of a new firewall, and improvements to sidewalks and planters around the perimeter of the property. 






Grace Center Particpant Demographics




PRIMARY HEALTH PROBLEMS OF GRACE CENTER PARTICIPANTS: 2015


