Grace Center's programs have enabled over **8,000 loved ones** to remain at home for as long as possible, either independently or with family members who are their caregivers. You have helped the caregivers by making it possible for them to remain in the workforce, providing respite from their 24/7 duties, and assisting them with support and education.



Your gift, **no matter what amount, makes a difference**. You might be surprised at how much we can do with even a modest gift. Here are some examples of how we make use of the funds we receive:

- \$25 allows us to provide a musical therapy performance for 30 people
- \$50 affords ceramic classes and supplies, 2 times a month
- \$100 provides an individual with compromised activities of daily living (ADLs) to receive a weekly shower for 1 month
- \$500 secures a family caregiver the ability to attend a monthly support group/training for an entire year while their loved one receives day services
- \$1000 offers 2 individuals 6 months' worth of weekly, 1 hour exercise and therapy sessions in our specialized post-rehabilitation gym
- \$1500 enables Grace Center to expand on innovative memory care practices, such as our newly established controlled multi-sensory environment (MSE) therapy room
